

New Taipei City Archaeology Park

Covering an area of 5.2 hectares, New Taipei City Archaeology Park is the largest archaeology-themed park in northern Taiwan. Planned as an urban literature and history garden, with Shihshanhang Culture as its subject, the park includes three main thematic areas: the Educational Performance Area, the Tribal Teaching Area, and the Hunting Education Area; these feature an experiential learning classroom, an interactive archaeology exploration pit, and indigenous-style house, grass-roofed shed, grain storage structure, village water channel, and other landscape displays. The park takes you back in time, letting you feel what life was like for the Shihshanhang people long ago.

Park Operating Hours (free entry)

Weekday, 9:30 am - 5:00 pm (Mon. - Fri.)

Weekend, 9:30 am - 6:00 pm (Sat., Sun. and National Holiday)

Park closed on the following

1. First Monday every month (but open if Monday is a national holiday or holiday make up day, then closed the next day)
2. Chinese New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year's Day
3. Work closure days due to natural disaster as announced by the government
4. Other times when it is necessary to close the park will be announced separately

- Exit 1 of Luzhou Station (MRT Zhonghe-Xinlu Line) → 704 Bus → Bali Administration Center (Shihshanhang Museum of Archaeology) Stop → walk 5 minutes down Shihshanhang Road

By Car


- Guandu Bridge → Provincial Highway 15 (toward Bali) → Zhonghua Road → Wenchang Road → Museum Road

Educational Performance Area

- 1. Interactive Archaeology Exploration Pit**
As the largest interactive archaeology exploration pit in Taiwan, it is an excellent place to learn about archaeological work.
- 2. Experiential Learning Classroom / Park Service Center**
Provides information to visitors and experiential classes.
- 3. Magical Archaeological Sandpit**
Combination of indoor sandpit and interactive technology.


Hunting Education Area

4. Hunting Lawn
Recreates the prehistoric village environment, with displays of prehistoric animal and plant ecology.


Tribal Teaching Area

- 5. Village Water Channel**
Recreates the living situation of the Shihsanhang people, who lived next to water.
- 6. Indigenous-style House**
Shihsanhang people built stilt-style houses using bamboo or wood.
- 7. Grain Storage Structure**
Shihsanhang people had the habit of storing their food in raised structures.
